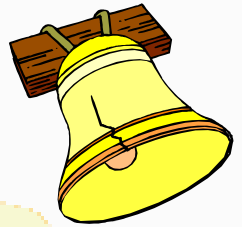
A special thanks to the ladies for bringing all the goodies to our meetings. Don't stop them from coming now. We love you all.

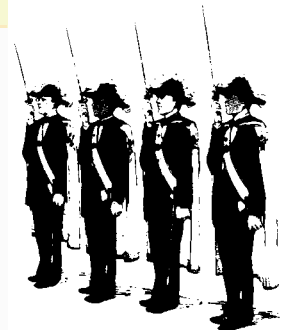
